Pre-release detainees need to be prepared for achieving stable and satisfactory employment.

European detainee population is young (median age 36 years)





42% will be released in between 1 to 5 years.



Prison education could help by increasing interpersonal comminucation skills (ICS), introducing positive civic values, and providing the necessary tools to solve social challenges.


